

Activity Accident Insurance Enrollment Form



Girl Scouts are always prepared! After your activity is approved*, please submit the completed activity accident insurance enrollment form with payment at least one week prior to the start of the activity.

1. Select Coverage Type

Descriptions of coverage are not contracts. The descriptions are summaries only and are not intended to describe the entire plan.

Basic Plan 1: Activity Accident Insurance automatically covers all members and invited nonmembers for any approved*, supervised Girl Scout Activity

- No costs; as the premium is paid for by GSUSA
- Automatically enrolled, no enrollment form needed
- Includes all trips, no matter the duration
- Covers travel to and from the activity
- Includes parents and caregivers, tagalongs (siblings/children) and younger children in Girl Scout supervised units
- Does not cover sickness, unless due to accidental injury (such as food poisoning, tainted water ingestion, tick bites resulting in Lyme's disease, etc.)

Plan 3P: Activity Accident Insurance plus Sickness Insurance covers accidents plus sickness for all members and invited nonmembers for any approved*, supervised Girl Scout Activity

- Enrollment form is required with payment at a cost of \$.70 per person/ per day
- Pays before personal medical insurance
- Policy limit is \$10,000
- Covers travel to and from the activity
- Sickness coverage is intended for extended or long-distance trips
- Plan 3P insurance must be ordered for the entire period of the event and for 100% of the participants

Plan 3PI: Activity Accident Insurance plus Sickness Insurance for International Trips covers accidents plus sickness for all members and invited nonmembers for any approved*, supervised International Girl Scout Activity

- Includes essentially same coverage as Plan 3P but with a Travel Assistance Service "safety net" feature added
- Enrollment form is required with payment at a cost of \$1.17 per person/ per day
- Pays before personal medical insurance
- Policy limit is \$10,000
