

Activity Accident Insurance Enrollment Form



Girl Scouts are always prepared! Troops need to purchase additional insurance for activities with non-registered members or overnight activities. After your activity is approved, please submit the completed activity accident insurance enrollment form with payment at least one week prior to the start of the activity.

1. Select Coverage Type

Descriptions of coverage are not contracts. The descriptions are summaries only and are not intended to describe the entire plan.

Plan 1—Accident Insurance

Covers every registered Girl Scout—girls and adults—for any approved, supervised activity of the Girl Scouts. The cost is paid by Girl Scouts of the USA as part of the annual membership dues fee. This insurance will provide coverage for injury due to an accident while on the way to, from, or at a Girl Scout-sponsored meeting or event. This plan is invalid for events lasting more than two nights, and additional insurance is required for events lasting three nights or more.

Plan 2—Accident Insurance

Covers Girl Scout members and non-members with a single enrollment form. The cost is \$0.11 per participant per calendar day. Plan 2 has the same coverage as listed in Plan 1. This is the minimum plan that must be purchased by registered members for events lasting 3 nights or more. This plan covers non-members as participants regardless of the length of the activity/event.

Plan 3E—Accident & Sickness Insurance

Covers Girl Scout members and non-members for events lasting three nights or more. The cost is \$0.29 per participant per calendar day. This insurance must be ordered for the entire period of the event and for 100% of the participants. Plan 3E provides coverage for loss resulting from injuries received or sickness contracted while the insured is: (a) attending or participating in any approved and supervised Girl Scout activity; or (b) traveling directly to and from any approved and supervised Girl Scout activity. Plan 3E insurance is secondary to an individual's or family's insurance. This plan is recommended for events taking place close to home, preferably within the HMO or PPO area of the family's insurance.

Plan 3P— Accident & Sickness Insurance

Covers Girl Scout members and non-members for events lasting three nights or more. The cost is \$0.70 per participant per calendar day. Plan 3P is the same as Plan 3E except that Girl Scout insurance is primary. Family insurance will be accessed only if the claim exceeds the Girl Scout insurance policy limit. This plan is highly recommended for trips of any distance from home.

2. Complete the activity accident insurance enrollment form

The minimum payment is \$5.00. Multiple activities and events can be listed on this form.

*The number of days is based on each day of the activity. For example, 10/1-10/3 is considered three days (not two nights).
