

Kaper Chart

As a troop, group or family, girls will make a Kaper Chart. A Kaper Chart is a chart used to decide the jobs that each girl needs to perform during a meeting and assures that everything gets done and everyone gets a chance to do every job. Kaper charts can be made to fit any group and can be as creative as the group wants them to be.

Examples of jobs on a troop chart might include:



- Promise and Law Leader
- Snack Helper
- Clean Up Manager
- Activity Assistant
- Closing Circle Leader
- Friendship Circle Squeeze Starter

Directions:

- Under each ladybug, write the names of each family member and cut out.
(Extra bugs can be kept or thrown away)
- On each petal of the daisy write a job that needs to be completed at home, such as dishes, trash, feeding the cat/dog, making the beds, etc.
- Using the enclosed Velcro, attached one dot to each petal and one of the opposite dots to each ladybug.
- Rotate the ladybugs each day so that every family member gets a chance to do each job.
- For your family, Include fun things like, dessert picker, bedtime reader, etc.
