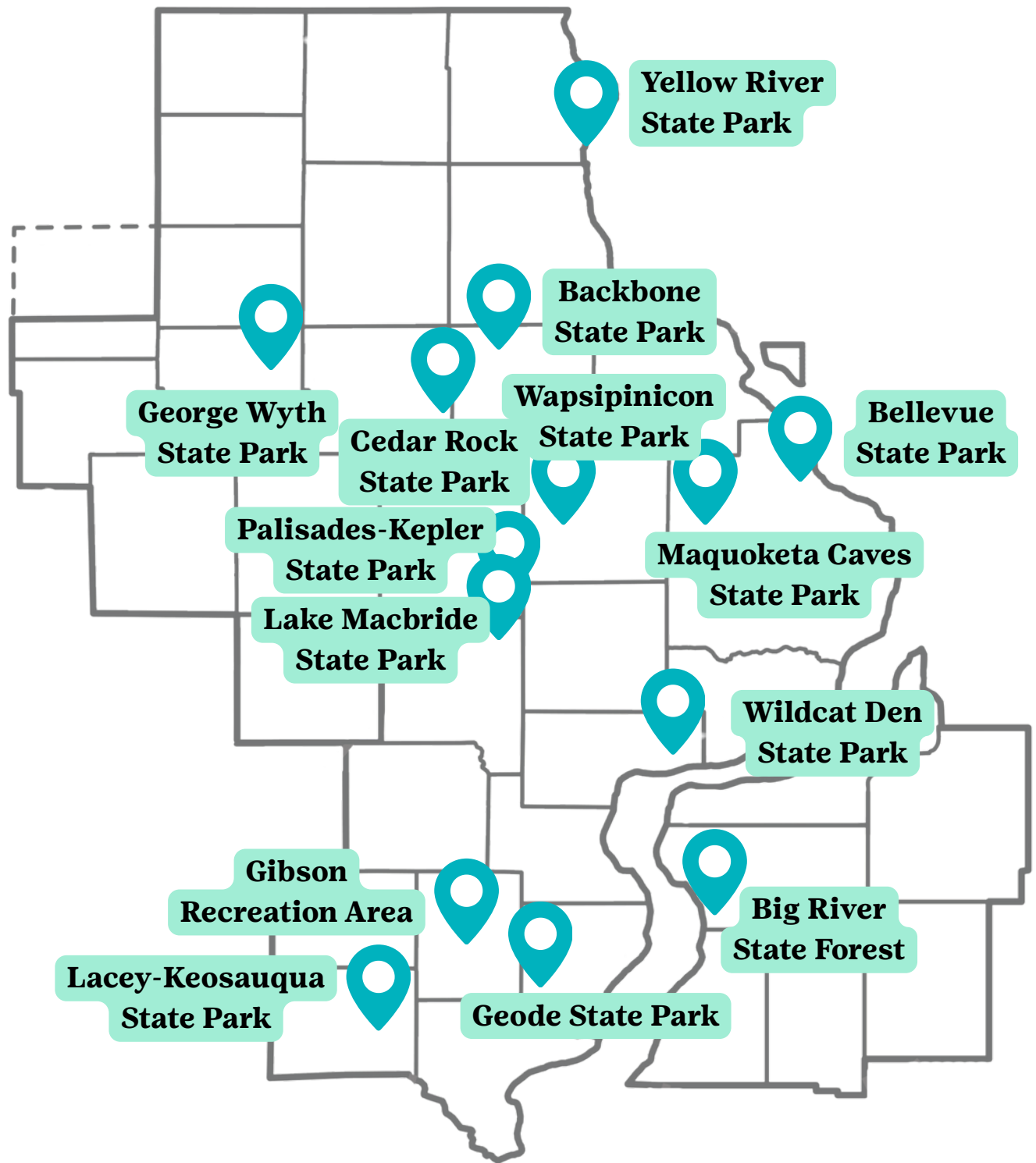
If you can't make it to a state park on this weekend—don't fret! You can still earn your patch by visiting a state park anytime during the year

Wildcat Den State Park

It might get a little muddy, but that's part of the fun!
