

Cadette, Senior, and Ambassador Girl Scouts should go "old school" and use a paper map! Using the map, girls should direct their parents or guardians to find each location.


Parents and guardians can scan the QR Codes on the map to identify the correct locations if needed. This challenge is on your honor so remember to be honest and fair Girl Scouts.
