Renew your Girl Scout Membership!

Thank you for leading your troop and creating unique experiences for your Girl Scouts! Together, we're creating a safe and supportive environment so all girls can become courageous and confident. As a thank you for renewing early, we are giving girls and volunteers who renew FREE troop shirts! They will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. You can contact your Community Engagement Manager or info@girlscoutstoday.org for shirt availability.

As you plan ahead, it's helpful for our council and your troop leadership to know who plans to continue next school year. As your troop decides which expenses are covered by the troop and which are covered by the family, the 2025-2026 Girl Scout membership fee will be \$45, and the adult membership fee will be \$30 for an entire year.

Girl Scout Experience Box for New Daisy or Brownie Troops

The Girl Scout Experience Box is a new program to provide leaders of first-year Girl Scout Daisy (grades K–1 in the 2025/2026 school year) and first-year Brownie (grades 2-3 in the 2025/2026 school year) troops with an amazing resource. This includes troops that are bridging from Daisy to Brownie!

Starting in August 2025, qualifying Daisy and Brownie troop leaders will receive a monthly supply box filled with step-by-step instructions, supplies, and thoughtful script suggestions. This complimentary resource will follow the [Daisy First Year Troop Plan](#) and the [Brownie First Year Troop Plan](#) and be delivered directly to troop leaders.

Each troop receives one box that contains enough ready-to-go supplies to serve all Girl Scouts in a troop and will help you build a stash of reusable items, such as child scissors. We'll update the number of Girl Scouts in your troop ahead of each shipment, so all you need to do is unbox the fun!

To receive your first box, each new Daisy and Brownie troop must:

- Register at least four new Daisy OR four new (or bridging) Brownie Girl Scouts
- Register at least one adult volunteer
