Journey Retirement and New Highest Award Prerequisites

You heard right! On July 14, Girl Scouts of the USA announced new Leadership Awards for Juniors through Ambassadors. <u>You can view all the new content on GSUSA's Leadership Award page</u> – including the guides with instructions on earning the new awards.

As part of this update, National Leadership Journeys will be retired over a one-year transition period. Importantly, there will be no impact on Girl Scouts who plan to or have already earned Journeys—if a Girl Scout has earned a Journey to be used as a prerequisite, it will never expire.

Explore Adult-Centered Digital Well-Being Resources on VTK

Meta and Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA) have partnered to provide volunteers, parents, and caregivers with four practical resources to help girls build positive digital habits. These tools offer guidance on fostering teens' digital well-being, including tips for starting open conversations about social media, managing screen time in an intentional and balanced way, and supporting youth through negative online experiences. The resources also highlight the importance of modeling positive digital behavior and using technology with intention.

Activity Accident Insurance Going Fully Automatic, Effective October 1, 2025

Effective October 1, 2025, Activity Accident Insurance will be completely automatic with no additional cost. In addition to accident/injury coverage for day events, the new policy will automatically include sickness coverage for all overnight stays (including camp) and international travel. This change, effective for trips occurring on and after October 1, 2025, eliminates the need for manual individual insurance requests entirely.
