WHY ARE TROOPS JOINING THE EXTENSION?

By continuing to sell Girl Scout Cookies, troops will be able to increase their earnings and achieve or surpass their cookie sales goals.

ARE THERE ANY NEW REWARDS?

Girls who participate in the extension will earn rewards, program credits, and a special edition winter post patch to match the other 2021 season patches. Troop Leaders will be able to order the patches in eBudde when they place the troop reward order. Patches will arrive with the full reward order in mid-late April.



HOW DOES THE EXTENSION EFFECT WHEN REWARDS ARRIVE?

Rewards will still arrive in mid-late April, 2021.

CAN MY TROOP NOT PARTICIPATE IN THE EXTENSION?

Participating in the season extension is completely optional.

CAN A GIRL SCOUT CONTINUE TO SELL IF HER TROOP IS NOT?

Yes! If a Girl Scout wants to continue to work toward her goals but Troop Leaders have opted not to sell through the extension period, the Troop Leader can still order her Winter Cookie patch. Troops Leaders can contact their local cookie cupboard to let them know which parents will be picking up additional cookies during the extension.

HOW DO TROOPS ORDER MORE COOKIES?

Troops should continue to place pending orders by 8 p.m. Sunday nights, contact a cookie cupboard, or use the Cookie Exchange in eBudde.

CAN TROOPS CONTINUE TO HOST COOKIE BOOTHS?

Yes, troops can still schedule booth sales and council sign-ups will be available in eBudde as well. Troops are encouraged to schedule and participate in the Community Cares Booths, too!

WILL MY LOCAL CUPBOARD BE OPEN?

A few local cupboards will remain open as well as all office locations.
